The CRS includes the Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (PCIA), which is either a charge or credit, designed to ensure that SCE's previously committed generation resource costs are not shifted to SCE's remaining customers. SCE bundled customers who participate in SCE's optional Green Rate program also pay a PCIA charge. The FF recovers taxes owed to a city in exchange for allowing SCE to utilize electrical distribution lines throughout the property of the city. SCE acts as the collection agency for the FF surcharge which is levied by cities and counties for all customers.
